December 2018

All the Dogs, Cats and Dolly the horse, the Employees and Board Members at the Marion Grant County Humane Society wish You, your Family and Pets a Joyful Holiday and a Wonderful New Year.

2018 is almost over and the Humane Society presently has 102 cats in the shelter, 45 cats in foster care, 60 dogs in the shelter and 10 dogs in foster care. The adoptions through November are 84 cats and 112 dogs in their forever homes. We have spayed and neutered 340 animals at the low cost clinics in Noblesville and Kokomo and at Pipe Creek Animal Clinic. The Noblesville Low Cost Transport program has had a great response from the public with an additional 120 animals spayed and neutered. There were 30 cats altered through the feral Trap Neuter and Return program. This year the Humane Society's veterinarian care expenses have exceeded \$30,000 with additional money raised for two animals that were treated in Indianapolis specialty hospital.

Many lives have been saved and changed with your donations and contributions along with your support for the Rescue Resale Shop, Pennies for Puppies, Basket Raffle, Silent Auction, First Friday Event, Grains & Grill Fall Festival, Spaghetti Supper Fund Raiser, Popcorn Festival, Tractor Supply Co. booth, Rock's Tenderloin Fundraiser, Collection jars in Grant County Businesses and Special Fundraisers.

Please know you are greatly appreciated and please consider making possibilities become realities with your 2018 end of the year contribution for the animals.
